

# Outdoor Recreation

## During the Safer at Home Order

### Applies to:

- Non-guided recreation: zip lines, ropes course, outdoor climbing walls, equipment rentals
- Guided recreation for (including overnight services) fishing, hiking, biking, horseback riding, canoeing, kayaking, stand-up paddle boarding, ATV tours, hunting, snowmobiling, skiing and climbing
- River outfitters, rafting, Jeep Tours
- Equipment rentals should follow retail guidelines

### Operations

- Participants:
  - Non-guided recreation: allowable in groups up to 10 participants
  - Guided services: allowable in groups up to 10 participants
  - River outfitters, rafting, or Jeep tours: parties are limited to participants of up to two households
    - Household is a family unit or group that lives together
    - Must be able to maintain 6 feet between household units
  - Wear face coverings as much as possible, when safe, including during staging and disembarking operations
- Physical distancing between participants and guides/staff must be maintained, except when it is unsafe to maintain
- Consider implementing a reservation system

- Vehicles
  - Windows should remain open during transportation
    - In case of inclement weather, which could lead to prolonged contact in an enclosed vehicle, the tour should be rescheduled
  - Smaller vehicles should be limited to two households with up to 10 people, not including guides
  - Large vehicles, large boats or trains, which can accommodate multiple household units, can do so with proper distancing
  - Buses and vans are limited to no more than 50% occupancy or less if distancing between groups cannot be maintained

## Staff

- Wear face coverings
  - During staging, disembarking, and when safe during trip operations
- Conduct symptom checks upon beginning shift
  - Symptomatic employees or those who develop symptoms while at work should remain at home or be sent home
  - Do not allow sick employees or employees who have been exposed to come to work for 14 days
- Conduct staging operations, customer check in-out, and end-of-trip operations outside

## Cleaning and Disinfection

- Post signage for employees and patrons about good hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette
- Encourage good hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette
- Vehicles must be cleaned and disinfected after each use
- All equipment must be cleaned and sanitized between uses
