



TANF Disaster Assistance Program

(Available due to COVID-19)



What is it?

- Emergency funding for those who have a child under the age of 18 and/or are pregnant and/or are the spouse of someone who is pregnant, all residing in the same home.
- The applicant must provide proof that there is a need for assistance as a result of COVID-19.
- All eligibility requirements will be based on household income.



Who might Qualify?

- An applicant that declares and provides proof that his/her household living expenses are greater than his/her current income as a result of the COVID-19.
- Example: Applicant might be on an unpaid leave of absence from work due to COVID-19 & will return to work.
- Applicant has returned to work, but working reduced hours causing the household's income to be reduced.



What should I know?

- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Lawful Permanent Residents of the United States.
- Must have applied or is applying for Unemployment Insurance Benefits
- The household's gross income must be under \$75,000 annually.
- Must be job attached & have OR will return to work.
- Must have a plan of how your household will stabilize financially after one time aid is provided (if eligible).
