

Frequently Asked Questions: Immunizations

1. How can I get a copy of my immunization record or locate my old records?

- If you have received immunizations at El Paso County Public Health, call (719) 578-3199, option 5. If your record is in the Colorado State Registry (Colorado Immunization Information System), follow the steps at <http://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/immunization-records>.
- Other ways to locate old immunization records include checking:
 - All previous health care providers
 - Your home (including asking your parents)
 - Schools, colleges, etc.
 - Previous employers
 - Local immunization registries

2. Can you bill my insurance?

- Low-cost vaccines are available for children who are:
 - Medicaid-eligible (including CHP+)
 - Uninsured
 - Underinsured
 - American Indian or Alaska Native
- El Paso County Public Health provides vaccinations for children who have insurance. Please call for more information on insurance providers accepted at our clinic.
- El Paso County provides vaccinations for adults who are:
 - Medicaid-eligible
 - Uninsured*
 - Underinsured*
 - Covered by some insurances (please call for more information on insurance providers accepted at our clinic).
- *Select low-cost immunizations are available for uninsured or underinsured adults. Please call if you have any questions.

3. Do I need to make an appointment?

- While we do offer a walk-in clinic on Tuesdays, appointments are encouraged.
 - Appointments are available Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. – 3 p.m.
 - Walk-in clinic is available every Tuesday from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. Wait times for walk-in clinic vary.
 - If you are seeking travel-related vaccinations, appointments are required.
