

Limited Health Care Settings

During the Safer at Home Order

Services in Limited Health Care Settings include but are not limited to:

- Acupuncture (not related to personal services)
- Athletic training (not related to personal services)
- Audiology services
- Services by hearing aid providers
- Chiropractic care
- Massage therapy (not related to personal services)
- Naturopathic care
- Occupational therapy services
- Physical therapy
- Speech language pathology services

Protect employees and work spaces

- Adhere to social distancing: Six feet between employees and customers
- Strict hygiene guidelines and sanitization procedures for all contact surfaces and tools/equipment
- Post signage on good hygiene and safety measures being taken
- Minimize in-home services when possible
- Conduct symptom and temperature checks for employees
- **Close personal contact must:**
 - Wear gloves and MEDICAL GRADE mask at all times
 - Change gloves and wash hands between customers
 - Clean/disinfect all tools and work spaces between customers
 - Maintain log of customer interactions
- **Low personal contact must:**
 - Maintain six feet separation and adhere to limit of 10 people
 - Require face coverings and, if feasible, gloves for all customer interactions

Protect Customers

- Conduct symptom and temperature checks (decline service to those with symptoms)
- By appointment-only services
- Schedule to allow adequate cleaning and disinfecting between patients
- Require use of face coverings by customers
- Contactless payment options preferred
- Maximize the use of telehealth and virtual visits
