

# Non-Critical Retail

## During the Safer at Home Order

### Non-Critical Retail includes but is not limited to:

- Large retail, department, discount, outlet stores:
  - Doors must open to the outdoors
  - **NO MALLS**
  - Clothing, home goods, mattress, appliances
- Motor vehicle dealerships
- Cell phone stores
- Thrift shops
- Apothecaries
- Vape/cigar shops (**NO ONSITE CONSUMPTION**)
- Craft stores
- Fishing tackle retailers
- Sporting goods
- Boutiques

### Protect Employees and Workspaces

- **May open up to a max of 50% occupancy, with the following:**
  - Six feet between employees and customers
  - Symptom and temperature checks for employees
  - Provide face coverings and gloves to employees
  - Ensure ability to adequately clean and disinfect retail space and backroom – inability to meet this requires continued curbside/delivery
  - Frequently clean high-touch surfaces
- Plexiglass screens at checkout counters
- Signage on good hygiene and sanitation practices
- Restrict return policy to items that can be sanitized before reselling
- No sampling or bulk bins
- Minimize exchange of debit/credit cards
- Encourage frequent hand washing
- Require employees to stay home when sick

### Protect Customers

- Maintain Social Distancing requirements
- Provide dedicated instore hours for vulnerable individuals
- Post signage notifying customers to not enter if they are sick
- Post signs encouraging the use of face masks
- Apply decals indicating safe distancing and establish one-way traffic flow through aisles
- Increase access to hand sanitizer and wipes for cleaning high touch surfaces, for both customers and employees
